### Juniors Rules

# 1 Pitching

15 yr olds can only pitch a total of 4 innings a game. A 14yr old or 13yr old will pitch the other 3 innings and must pitch by the 4th inning.

All pitchers are allowed to pitch no more than 3 innings a game.

Any pitcher may be reinserted in the game as a pitcher 1 time as long as he has innings left. An intentional walk may be given without throwing to the batter.

# 2 Batting

All players on the team will bat. If a player shows up late he will be placed at the bottom of the order.

If a player has to leave for an illness or any other reason, it will not be an out. If a player has been ejected from the game, his spot in the order shall be an out when his spot gets back up. All bats mirror high school and must be a drop 3 and no barrels to exceed 2 %

### 3 Sliding

Head first slides are permitted.

Cleats should be down when sliding. Umpires discretion if he believes the slider is trying to injure the defensive player.

If there is a play at the base, runner should slide to avoid contact. This is also umpires discretion.

Barreling into a player to jar the ball loose is prohibited. If the throw is errant and causes a collision it is also umpires discretion as to whether contact could have been avoided.

### 4 Substitutions

Free substitution of all players.

No player should sit more than 2 innings in a 7 inning game.

All players should sit once prior to someone sitting twice.

If a player is being sat for discipline, the umpire and opposing coach must be notified. Violation of this rule will not be tolerated to gain a competitive edge. Could result in forfeiture of the game. Courtesy runners will be allowed for catchers after 2 outs to speed up the game.

If a team is short of 9 players you make pick up a sub from another team. The player must bat last and play outfield.

### 5 Games

Games shall consist of 7 innings, however no new inning may start after the 2 hour time limit.

Any new inning started shall be completed.

6 Run Rules

Mercy rule will be in effect for lopsided games. 15 run lead after 4 innings and 10 run lead after 5 innings. 8 runs per inning limit.

7 Ejections

Any manager, player, coach or spectator who is ejected will miss the teams next game.

8 All other rules will follow babe Ruth rules.

All efforts will be made to make up rainouts.
